What is Catechesis?

Catechesis is a responsibility of the entire Christian community. This should not be the work of catechists and priests alone, but of the whole community of the faithful. The Christian community follows the development of catechetical processes, for children, young people and adults, as a duty that involves and binds it directly. (GDC 220) A fully Christian community can exist only when a systematic catechesis of all its members takes place and when an effective and well developed catechesis of adults is regarded as the central task of the catechetical enterprise." (ACCC, no. 25).

Do you feel the calling to share your faith with the children in our parish community? Are you interested in volunteering to be a catechist or aide? Faith Formation classes meet weekly beginning in late September and run through mid-April. We are always looking for committed volunteers. Training in our curriculum and ongoing support is provided.

Please give careful consideration to the possibility of being a volunteer catechist or aide. Sharing your faith on a weekly basis with the children in our parish can be a life changing experience! Please pray about this and then give me a call. I would be happy to answer any questions.

YANKEES/METS SUBWAY SERIES BUS TRIP

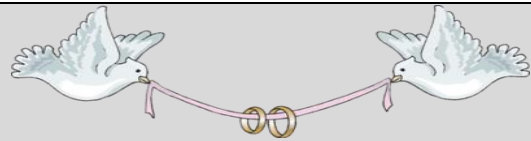
