

GRADE SEVEN
MONDAY EVENINGS 7:30 – 9:00 PM

In the seventh grade, students will come to know Jesus using the textbook *Be my Disciples: Christ in the New Testament*.

We read in sacred scripture, “Jesus himself drew near and walked with them, ...” (Luke 24:15). As two disciples walk along the road to Emmaus, not far from Jerusalem, a stranger, as yet unrecognized as Jesus, joins them and begins a conversation with them. This story from scripture communicates to us that Jesus patiently walks with us on our own journeys of faith and we must be open to his presence.

While studying *Christ in the New Testament*, students will realize that Jesus invites them (and us) to be his disciples. He wants us to know him better, to understand his message, and to follow his way of life. During this course of study, the students will explore God’s Word in the New Testament. They will discover how the Holy Spirit inspires and empowers them to live in communion with the Holy Trinity, strengthening their personal relationship with God in community.

Our book is divided into two units. During the first semester, the students will focus on Unit 1: The Good News of Jesus. During the second semester, the focus will be on Unit 2: Proclaiming the Gospel. **Please note that if a student is absent from class, all work for that date is to be done at home.*
