## From the Desk of Fr. Jared

May 13<sup>th</sup> is the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima. This year we are celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the apparitions of our Blessed Mother at Fatima. The message of Fatima, strengthened and authenticated by fulfillment of its prophecies in history, remains as needed today as it was when Lucia and her two cousins Jacinta and Francisco heard it from the lips of Our Lady. Today, Mary repeats for each of us the first words of Jesus in his public ministry. She brings to us Christ's call to conversion. "The kingdom of God is close at hand. Repent and believe the gospel" (Mk 1:15). At Fatima, Our Lady asked us to find in her heart the door to Christ. By consecrating ourselves to her Immaculate Heart, we accept the will of Christ who gave Mary to be our Mother. As we celebrate the centenary of these apparitions, we have an opportunity this weekend to consecrate ourselves to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Now what does that mean? On October 31, 1942, Pius XII made a solemn Act of Consecration of the Church and the whole world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, joined by the bishops of Portugal, gathered at the Cathedral in Lisbon. He then dedicated the whole human race to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. *"Consecration to the Mother of God,"* he said, *"is a total gift of self, for the whole of life and for all eternity; and a gift which is not a mere formality or sentimentality, but effectual, comprising the full intensity of the Christian life - Marian life."* The goal of any devotional practice does not end at a Saint or an object and in this case the Blessed Mother. Rather, it is a way to Jesus. We do not worship saints, they intercede for us before God. We recognize their holiness not only in life, but ultimately now as they are in the presence of God, they *"on whose constant intercession in your presence we rely for unfailing help"* (Eucharistic Prayer III, Roman Missal). By our consecration, we promise to become dependent on Mary in all things: to offer all our prayers to God through Mary, and to seek every gift from God through Mary. And we do this with the greatest confidence. Since she is our mother, she knows our needs better than we; we trust in her knowledge and her desire to fill us with the grace of God.

It is always a beautiful connection that we celebrate Mother's Day in May when we honor our Blessed Mother. We honor all our mothers in a special way today. We give thanks to God for our mothers and the beautiful examples of love they have showed us and continue to show us. We pray for mothers who have died, those who are ill, and those who struggle(d) with their vocation of motherhood. Mary our Blessed Mother guide and protect all mothers today and every day!
