#### **First Reading: Jeremiah 20:10-13**

Maybe being a catechist is something you feel God is calling you to, but you have some reservations. Joe Paprocki, Dmin, a former Director of Religious Education, addressed common concerns, publishing the following on his website, "Catechist's Journey" ([www.catechistsjourney.org](http://www.catechistsjourney.org)).

***"I'm hesitant to become a catechist because I don't know if I can handle a group of kids. I don't know if kids will like me."***

Everyone is nervous going into a classroom on their first day of teaching (Some of us were nervous for our first several weeks of teaching). The good news is that the children already what acceptable behavior is and what it is not. The bad news is that they will sometimes act up. Children thrive when there are clear expectations for their behavior and clear consequences for when they step out of line. If you are friendly, fair, and firm with your students, classroom discipline comes easier. And people of all ages like others who are friendly, fair, and firm.
